DR MAHATHIR SAYS DEVELOPING COUNTRIES SHOULD WORK TOGETHER

KUALA LUMPUR, June 17 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad says there is a need for developing countries to work together and adopt a common stand in the fight against discriminative policies of the developed nations.

The Prime Minister said it was obvious that developed countries were ganging-up against the developing nations including members of the G-15 grouping.

"All the policies that they have formulated are directed at exploiting the developing countries," he told reporters after opening the MCA 47th annual general meeting at Wisma MCA here today.

Dr Mahathir said this when asked about his hopes for the upcoming G-15 summit in Cairo and its relevance to Malaysia.

Dr Mahathir leaves for the Egyptian capital later today.
