EASY WINS FOR PERAK AND TERENGGANU IN PRELIMINARY ROUNDS

KUALA TERENGGANU, March 4 (Bernama) -- Defending champions Perak and runners-up Terengganu clinched easy wins in the preliminary rounds of the Boys' Under-15 PHM/Milo/MSN at Batu Buruk hockey stadium here today.

Perak whipped Kedah 9-0 in Group A while Terengganu beat Selangor 7-1 in Group B in the championship, officiated by Education Director-General Datuk Dr Abdul Shukor Abdullah last night.

Perak led 4-0 in the first half with the first scored by Selvaraju Sandrakasi in the fourth minute.

Kedah tried to stop the onslaught but failed as Perak continued to score until the final whistle.

Perak's other scorers were Chandramohan Balachandran, Mohd Adzuan Rosli, Mohd Hamzaid Mokhtar, Mahendran Subramaniam and Chin Kok San.

Meanwhile, the Terengganu-Selangor match was also one-side with the home team, punishing the visitors as early as the six minute through Mahathir Fitri Mokhtar.

By the end of first half, Terengganu were already ahead with three goals to nothing. The match ended 7-1 in Terengganu's favour.

In another Group B match, Pahang beat Kelantan 7-0 after leading 3-0 at half time.
