`Federal Territory Mosque is a joint-venture effort'

KUALA LUMPUR, Fri. - Johawaki Sdn Bhd has clarified that the construction of the Federal Territory Mosque was a joint-venture effort with Ahmad Zaki Sdn Bhd.

Johawaki executive director Othman Md Taib said the contract was awarded to a joint-venture company - JV Johawaki-Ahmad Zaki.

In an article "Mosque Will Be The Pride Of KL" published on Oct 27 in the New Straits Times, it had attributed the construction work to Ahmad Zaki Sdn Bhd without any reference to Johawaki, which was equally responsible for its completion.

"As an affected party, we are very much concern over the misleading facts. Therefore, we would appreciate it if you could take the necessary action on this matter," Othman said in a statement.

The construction costs for the exquisite mosque were contributed by Muslims through the FT Mosque Development Fund, launched by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad three years ago.
