KHALIL PREPARED TO HEAR VIEWS ON CHANGE

REMBAU, June 6 (Bernama) -- Tan Sri Khalil Yaakob, who was re-appointed Umno secretary-general yesterday, said he is prepared to hear the views of the supreme council members who want a fresh approach.

He said such views were conveyed to him at the council meeting yesterday, the first to be held after the general assembly last month which saw the election of a new council line-up for the next three years.

He said the views were very useful and the secretariat would consider constructive proposals which could raise the party's image and make the members more dedicated.

He thanked Umno president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad for his trust in re-appointing him secretary-general of the party.

"I, Tun Daim (Zainuddin) and Datuk Mustapa (Mohamed) will discharge our duties as expected of us," he said.

Yesterday, Dr Mahathir announced that Khalil and Daim would retain their posts as secretary-general and treasurer respectively while Mustapa would replace Datuk Dr Yusof Nor as Umno information chief.

On the appointment of state Umno liaison chiefs and 10 supreme council members, Khalil said Dr Mahathir would take into account the views of all parties before making a decision.
