Kuan Yew to call on Daim at start of four-day working visit

KUALA LUMPUR, Sat. - Singapore Senior Minister Lee Kuan Yew will meet Finance Minister Tun Daim Zainuddin on Monday, the first day of his working visit to Malaysia.

The former Prime Minister will attend a dinner hosted by Daim at Mandarin Oriental hotel.

On the second day of his four-day visit, Lee will meet Petronas chairman Tan Sri Azizan Zainul Abidin before calling on Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi separately. Lee will later attend a dinner hosted by Dr Mahathir.

On Wednesday, he will attend a forum entitled East Asia's Status in the 21st Century, organised by the Institute of Strategic and International Studies (ISIS).

The last day of his visit will see Lee attending a reception at the Royal Selangor Golf Club after receiving a courtesy call from Defence Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak at his hotel suite.

Lee will also tour the Kuala Lumpur International Airport in Sepang before departing for Singapore in the evening.
