MAHATHIR LAUNCHES UMNO BUREAU'S SERVICE CENTRE

PETALING JAYA, Oct 18 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamed tonight launched the Umno Civil Action Bureau's service centre at an industrial zone in Sungai Way here.

It is set up among others to help workers and residents in the area to equip themselves with mental and physical strength.

The service centre is the first project of the Civil Action Bureau headed by Umno Supreme Council member Azalina Othman Said.

The project, which also includes activity and training centres, is expected to benefit some 35,000 factory workers in the area.
