MAHATHIR OPENS MALAYSIAN INC SUMMIT

KUALA LUMPUR, July 24 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad today opened the Malaysia Incorporated Summit here to discuss the effectiveness of the Malaysia Incorporated concept and further refinements to take the country to the next level of achievement.

It would also provide a forum for both the public and the private sector to channel views and suggestions to the government.
