MAHATHIR TO MAKE TWO-DAY VISIT TO BRUNEI

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 27 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad will make a two-day working visit to Brunei beginning Sunday in conjunction with the fourth annual consultations between him and Sultan Hassanal Bolkiah.

Dr Mahathir will be accompanied by wife Datin Seri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohamed Ali and a 43-member delegation, including Deputy Foreign Minister Datuk Leo Michael Toyad and senior government officials, a Wisma Putra statement said today.

The prime minister will have a four-eye discussion with Sultan Hassanal Bolkiah on bilateral as well as regional and international issues.

The Ruler will also host a dinner in honour of Dr Mahathir.

Dr Mahathir is also expected to meet the Malaysian community in Brunei and have lunch with them, the statement added.
