Malay rights: BN Youth to meet editors

SHAH ALAM, Sat. - The Barisan Nasional Youth will meet all newspaper editors to explain the movement's stand pertaining to the Malay rights and privileges raised by the Election Appeals Committee of the Chinese Associations of Malaysia (Suqiu).

Its head, Datuk Hishammuddin Hussein, said the move was necessary to "clear the air".

He said this was because some parties had accused them of inciting and playing up the Malay sentiments and racial issue when the matter was already considered closed.

"In fact, I have met Prime Minister and BN chairman Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad to explain the developments and to inform him of our stand and actions which we will be taking."
