Perak Umno divisions will be taking turns at holding meetings

IPOH, Sun. - The Perak Umno liaison committee meetings, once confined to the meeting rooms of the State party headquarters, will now be held in the other 23 divisions.

Perak Umno chief Datuk Seri Tajol Rosli Ghazali said the move followed the recent announcement by party president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad that supreme council meetings would now be held in other places apart from Kuala Lumpur.

Tajol Rosli, who is Menteri Besar, said this would enable leaders to get to know their divisions better.

"Arrangements will be made to hold the monthly State Umno liaison meetings at places such as the playground in a residential area or a Sunday market site or somewhere which will bring us closer to the community.

"After the meeting, probably in the morning, we will adjourn for lunch, for example, at one of the hawker stalls nearby," he said after the launch of the Lions Clubs millennium capsule here.

Tajol Rosli said the State Umno meetings would be a full-day affair and ceramah would be held in the evenings to bring leaders closer to members and community.

"After all, it is not everyday that we get to see the rakyat ... when they invite us for a function, it is only proper that we accord them with the respect they deserve."
