PERODUA-PAPERLESS

PERODUA TO GO ON PAPERLESS SALES AND REGISTRATION

KUALA LUMPUR, June 14 (Bernama) -- Perusahaan Otomobil Kedua Sdn Bhd (Perodua), is in the final stage of implementing a paperless sales and registration of its vehicles, said its chairman, Raja Tun Mohar Raja Badiozzaman.

In his address at the launching of Perodua's latest model, the Kenari here today, he said the paperless initiative involved the company, the Road Transport Department, the Customs Department and financial institutions.

Kenari, the fourth model by the second national car manufacturer after the Kancil, Rusa and Kembara was launched by the Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad at a colourful ceremony.

Part of the arrangement under the paperless initiative would include electronic banking, he said adding that Perodua had identified information technology (IT) as the way to move forward.

Along with its strategic partner, Daihatsu Corporation of Japan, he said Perodua regarded IT as one of the steps that could help the company achieve its corporate vision of becoming a well-known compact car manufacturer in Asean.

On the Kenari, a one-litre mini station wagon, Raja Tun Mohar said the car was expected to be well received by the young executives and buyers with families. --BERNAMA
