PM to celebrate Teachers' Day

IPOH, Sat. - Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad is scheduled for a half-day visit to Perak on Tuesday where he will open the national-level Teachers' Day celebrations.

According to a statement from the Menteri Besar's office, the Prime Minister is expected to arrive at the Sultan Azlan Shah Airport at 9.30am and proceed to the Bangunan Perak Darul Ridzuan.

There, he will inspect a guard-of-honour mounted by the Army Cadet Corps of Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan Anderson before launching the event at the Dewan Bankuet.

Education Minister Tan Sri Musa Mohamad and Director-General of Education Datuk Seri Dr Abdul Shukor Abdullah are expected to be present.

The Prime Minister will also present awards to winners of the various competitions held in conjunction with the celebrations, including a creative writing contest and teachers' debate.

Five teachers will receive the Tokoh Guru (exemplary teacher) awards.
