PPP welcomes Kayveas' appointment

PENANG, Tues. - The State PPP today lauded the appointment of its national president Datuk M. Kayveas as a Senator.

State PPP chairman Dr J. Logabala Mohan who described it as "long awaited" reward for the PPP, thanked Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad for giving recognition to the party.

He said Kayveas' appointment was viewed as "a reward for the party and the members, for having played an active role in the Barisan Nasional coalition".
