PRESIDENT OF BOTSWANA TO VISIT MALAYSIA

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 20 (Bernama) -- President Festus Mogae of Botswana will make a four-day working visit to Malaysia beginning Wednesday.

President Mogae is at present attending the Langkawi International Dialogue (LID). It will be his second visit to Malaysia.

He made a similar post-LID working visit last year, a Wisma Putra statement said today.

The president will be accompanied by his wife, Barbara Mogae, Minister of Commerce and Industry Tebelelo Seretse, senior government officials and a business delegation.

President Mogae is scheduled to meet Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad on Wednesday and attend a dinner hosted by Dr Mahathir in the evening.

He will deliver a keynote address at an investment seminar organised by the Botswana Export Development and Investment Agency (Bedia), here, on Thursday.

He is also scheduled to tour the Paya Indah Wetlands Sanctuary and meet Botswana students studying here.
