PROTON WAJA ON DISPLAY AT NATIONAL SCIENCE CENTRE

KUALA LUMPUR, July 7 (Bernama) -- Members of the public visiting the National Science Centre in Bukit Kiara, here, will be able to get a close look at the Proton Waja car which will be on display at its gallery from today.

The centre's assistant director Choong Kok Eng said the car, which would be a permanent feature was the gallery's latest attraction.

Besides a silver model, the prototype of the car was also displayed.

The Proton Waja, the first national car to be 100 per cent designed by locals, was launched by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad on May 8.

Bookings will open next months and 50,000 units are expected to be sold in its first year.

The National Science Centre is open from 9am to 5pm daily except for Friday. Adults are charged an entrance fee of RM6, children aged 6 to 12 (RM3), primary schoolchildren (RM2) and secondary schoolchildren (RM3).
