SELANDAR UMNO DIVISION NOMINATES MAHATHIR AND ABDULLAH

ALOR GAJAH, March 12 (Bernama) -- The Selandar Umno division today nominated Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad for party president and Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi for the deputy presidency.

For the three vice-president posts, it nominated incumbents Datuk Seri Najib Razak and Tan Sri Mohamad Mohamad Taib and Negeri Sembilan Menteri Besar Tan Sri Mohd Isa Samad.

The Selandar division, which made the nominations at its delegates meeting today, is the second in Melaka after Batu Berendam to choose Dr Mahathir and Abdullah for the top two posts.

For the Supreme Council seats, the division nominated Melaka Chief Minister Datuk Wira Mohamed Ali Rustam, Menteris Besar Tan Sri Shahidan Kassim (Perlis), Datuk Seri Syed Razak Syed Zain (Kedah), Datuk Seri Tajol Rosli Ghazali (Perak) and Datuk Adnan Yaakob (Pahang) and Penang Deputy Chief Minister Datuk Dr Helmi Yahaya.

Others nominated to sit in the council are Datuk Azmi Khalid, Datuk Abdul Kadir Sheikh Fadzir, Senator Datuk Paduka Dr Abdul Hamid Othman, Datuk Mohamed Nazri Aziz, Tan Sri Kasitah Gadam, Datuk Abdul Aziz Shamsuddin, Datuk Suleiman Mohamad, Datuk Mohamed Shafie Apdal, Datuk Dr Shafie Mohamed Salleh, Datuk Ahmad Zahid Hamidi, Datuk Ishak Ismail, Datuk Hassan Ariffin, Datuk Zainal Abidin Abdul Kadir, Tan Sri Rahim Tamby Chik, Daruk Dr Tengku Mahmud Mansor, Datuk Shahrir Abdul Samad, Abdul Azim Zabidi, Datuk Shahrizat Abdul Jalil and Datuk Maznah Hamid.
