Serve the rakyat, Cuepacs tells civil servants

IPOH, Fri. - Cuepacs wants civil servants to serve the rakyat and not play politics.

President N. Siva Subramaniam said today such employees must remember they were paid from taxpayers money to serve the Government.

"Public sector employees must be loyal to the Government which was elected by the people," he said.

He said this in response to a statement by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad who yesterday related that many civil servants had openly confessed that they were Pas supporters.

Dr Mahathir said this included a secretary-general of a ministry. However, he was not removed.

Meanwhile, a national consumer body wants an investigation to be carried out why bank employees who are said to be supporters of Opposition parties are divulging information pertaining to government financial transactions.

Federation of Malaysian Consumers Association deputy president Abdul Rahman Said Alli said today the probe must be thorough.

Dr Mahathir revealed yesterday that bank employees who sympathised with Opposition parties were leaking information on individual and government financial transactions.
