UMNO TO BASE NEW INFO CAMPAIGN ON ELECTION POST-MORTEM REPORT

BESUT, Jan 15 (Bernama) -- Umno's new nationwide information campaign will be based on the general election post-mortem report and feedback from various groups, party Information Chief Datuk Dr Yusof Nor said today.

The campaign was being mounted to enable Umno to regain its influence particularly in the states of Terengganu and Kelantan now administered by PAS, he said.

Among those who provided the feedback were professionals and individuals as well as Non-Governmental Organisations, he told reporters after hosting a Hari Raya open house at his residence here.

"The report has since been handed over to party president and Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad," he said.

"The report will enable Umno to identify the problems it faced in the various states as well as the causes for its defeat in Terengganu and Kelantan."

Yusof said the post mortem report also revealed the activities of foreign groups which were out to topple the Barisan Nasional especially Dr Mahathir.

"The aim of foreign groups with vested interests was to topple the BN leadership and use PAS as a vehicle to achieve their objectives. PAS is only a vehicle for them and they did not accept PAS as a party that can administer," Yusof Nor said.

The post mortem report also showed that the new generation did not get a clear picture of Umno's struggle and this group would be a target of the Umno information campaign, he said.
