The four Universiti Teknologi Malaysia students received their top prize of RM2,500 and certificates from Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad at the opening of the Malaysian Structural Steel Association convention and exhibition 2000 at Seri Kembangan.

The competition was organised by the Malaysian Structural Steel Association and open to local undergraduates.

The objective was to use steel as an alternative structural material for modern buildings.

The second and third prizes were also won by UTM. The second prize of RM1,500 went to Kan Hoi Ching, Khor Xin Ni, Lau Siong Weng, Tan Khang Khai and The Thiam Chuan.

The winners of the third prize which carried a RM1,000 purse were Tony Chong, Khor Ching Wei, Tan Chee Young, Tham Chee Meng and Ching Yik Fong.

UTM also won the Malaysian Structural Steel Association Challenge trophy.
