`Well conducted party special general assembly'

KUALA LUMPUR, Sun. - Senai Umno division chief Adam Hamid today praised the party leadership for adopting a very "open" approach during the one day Umno special general assembly yesterday.

He said the leadership took time to listen carefully to various opinions from the delegates and ensured that everyone had a chance to speak.

"This really reflects the true democracy within the party," he said when commenting on the overall proceedings yesterday.

He said he was satisfied with the discussions on the setting up of Puteri Umno and with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's sensitivity in considering delegate's views.

"Even when the delegates rejected one of the amendments, the leaders accepted it positively. The delegates were very attentive throughout the proceeding."

He welcomed the move to set up a disciplinary committee to determine procedures, its powers and to impose punishment for violating the constitution and other offences listed in the membership ethics.
