Zainol Mahmood appointed Tabung Haji chairman

KANGAR, Sat. - Pos Malaysia Bhd executive chairman Tan Sri Zainol Mahmood had been appointed Tabung Haji chairman, replacing Tan Sri Ahmad Razali Mohd Ali.

Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Abdul Hamid Othman said the appointment which was approved by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad is effective from Aug 1.

The appointment is for two years.

Abdul Hamid made the announcement after opening a convention of religious teachers here today.

He said Zainol, 63, had vast experience in managing such an organisation based on his 39 years in the civil service and his good record as Pos Malaysia executive chairman, a position he held since 1992.

Abdul Hamid said he was confident Tabung Haji, which currently has assets worth RM9 billion and managed a yearly transaction of about RM2 billion, would further improve its performance under Zainol's leadership.
