

# Do your job well, PM tells newly-elected Umno division heads

**KUALA LUMPUR, Thurs:** Umno president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad has advised five new faces elected as division heads in party elections held so far to discharge their duties efficiently.

"Since they have been elected, they should carry out their duties accordingly.

"Those who lost should give their support to those who won," the prime minister told reporters after launching "Silverfil", a silver-based dental filling material, at the Technology Park in Bukit Jalil today.

The new faces are Datuk Dr Nik Zain Omar (Pengkalan Chepa), Datuk Ahmad Saad (Permatang Pauh), Datuk Suhaili Abdul Rahman (Labuan), Datuk As-taman Abdul Aziz (Wangsa Maju) and Datuk Mohamed

Jaafar (Mentakab).

So far, 24 out of 165 divisions have held their annual general meetings. The rest must hold their AGMs by the end of the month.

Regarding money politics in some divisions Mahathir said action will be taken if there is proof.

However, all this while, people talk about money politics but when asked for proof, there's none.

"We cannot act on accusations which are made without proof," he said.

On Datuk Seri Rafidah Aziz's call for the abolition of nominations contenders must receive to contest party posts, Mahathir said the decision was made by the party's supreme council.

"The decision was made by the supreme council and not by me alone," he said.
