

Suhakam chairman dubbed 'Musa the Black' for alleged vendetta against Dr M

A delegate criticised Malaysia Human Rights Commission chairman Tan Sri Musa Hitam, calling him "Musa the Black".

Datuk Ibrahim Ali claimed Musa's lengthy discourse on human rights and democracy are,

in fact, a personal campaign against Mahathir.

He said people may think the term "haprak" (idiots) used by Mahathir in his speech on Thursday refers to sycophants like PAS, which likes to flatter the for-

eigners, when it actually refers to people like Musa.

"There is a long-drawn personal vendetta against the party president, and Musa has not forgotten his past losses. He wants to get Datuk Seri (Mahathir). His

revenge is not over," Ibrahim said.

He said Musa's call for the people not to fight globalisation, and to embrace human rights and democracy "is pure nonsense".

"I want to tell him that democracy is only applicable and accept-

able here so long as the rights and status of Malays are not challenged and threatened," he said.

"If the Malays are threatened, there will be no democracy and we will fight till the last drop of blood."
