

# Daim not going to be arrested, says Mahathir

Umno president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad said former Finance Minister Tun Daim Zainuddin is not going to be arrested and there is no restriction on

his movements.

Denying any knowledge that Daim is currently overseas, he said: "I don't know where he is."

At a press conference at

the end of the second day of the Umno general assembly, Mahathir said: "I saw him just before the assembly, but he didn't tell me that he was going abroad."

"He just said it would be a problem. He said if he goes abroad, the press is going to speculate that he is avoiding arrest. He is not going to be arrested and

there is no restriction on his movements."

Daim, who is MP for Merbok, resigned from all his posts in the government and party on June 1.
