# Putrajaya housebuyers still waiting for CF

**PUTRAJAYA, Sat:** Many people are not able to move into the houses they bought in Putrajaya because they have yet to be issued with the certificates of fitness (CF).

Expressing concern, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad today urged the relevant authorities to expedite the issuance of CF for the houses in Putrajaya.

He was speaking to the media after launching the Prime Minister's Department's family day activities at the Wetland Park here.

In his speech earlier, he expressed "loneliness" as there are not many people staying in Putrajaya, saying: "I hope more people will move here and I will no longer feel lonely."

He said there are only 28 registered voters in Putrajaya as told to him by Election Commission chairman Datuk Abdul Rashid Abdul Rahman.

On another matter, Mahathir said PAS president Datuk Fadzil Noor should be consistent in showing his support for the Human Rights Commission (Suhakam).

Yesterday, Fadzil questioned Suhakam chairman Tan Sri Musa Hitam's call for all parties to give their trust to the government to deal with the terrorism issue in its own way.

Fadzil has said it is improper for Musa, being a Suhakam member, to say democracy and basic human rights do not get priority in times like this.

Mahathir said as Malaysian citizens, everyone, including Fadzil, should feel responsible in this situation and support the government.

On Fadzil's call to Musa to differentiate between his current position in Suhakam and his past position as deputy prime minister, Mahathir said it is not wrong for Suhakam to share the government's view for the right cause.
