

440 Putrajaya homes without CFO, says Ong

KUALA LUMPUR, Sun: Only 440 of about 5,200 houses in Putrajaya are yet to be issued with the certificate of fitness and occupation (CFO) as the developer has not applied for it.

Housing and Local Government Minister Datuk Seri Ong Ka Ting said a report submitted by Putrajaya Corporation on Monday states that the company has built about 5,200 houses in Putrajaya.

"Of the amount, about 4,800 houses have been issued the CFO while there is no application from the developer for the 440 houses," Ong told reporters after

launching the National Recycling-Day at Bukit Jalil stadium here today

He said of the 4,800 houses, about 2,000 houses are unoccupied for unknown reasons.

According to Ong, Putrajaya Corporation said it did not do anything to delay the issuance of CFO and has closely followed all existing guidelines.

On Nov 3, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad expressed concern over the matter.

The prime minister urged the relevant authorities to expedite the issuance of the CFO.
