

Members of royal family, PM visit King at medical centre

KUALA LUMPUR: Members of the royal family yesterday visited the Yang di-Pertuan Agong Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah, who is receiving further medical treatment at the Gleneagles Intan Medical Centre.

Agong Tuanku Siti Aishah arrived at the medical centre at 10.35am followed by the Acting Yang di-Pertuan Agong Sultan Mizan Zainal Abidin who was accompanied by his consort Permaisuri Nur Zahirah 45 minutes later. They were met on arrival by

the medical centre's chief executive officer Stuart J.V. Pack.

The Raja Muda of Kedah arrived at about noon while Yang di-Pertuan Besar Negri Sembilan Tuanku Ja'afar and his consort Tuanku Najihah arrived an hour later.

The King's sister Tengku Ampuan Bariah arrived at 3pm followed by the Regent of Selangor Raja Idris Shah 15 minutes later. Also there was his grandson Tengku Syed Budriz Jamallulail.

Others who visited the King were Selangor Mentri Besar

Datuk Seri Dr Mohamad Khir Toyo and Deputy Home Minister Datuk Chor Chee Heung and Deputy Minister of Science, Technology and Environment Datuk Zainal Dahalan.

At about 9.40pm, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr

Mahathir Mohamad and his wife Datin Seri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali visited the King.

The King returned home on Sunday after a recent minor surgery to have a pacemaker implanted at Mount Elizabeth Hospital in Singapore on Oct 6.
