Academy donates RM20,000

KUALA LUMPUR, Wed. - More donations are being made by companies, organisations and individuals from all over the country for the restoration of Universiti Malaya's Dewan Tunku Canselor, razed by a fire on June 29.

Yesterday, president and chancellor of Manipal Academy of Higher Learning, Dr Ramdas M. Pai, donated RM20,000.

A mock cheque was presented to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad during the inauguration of the Malacca Manipal Medical College at its campus in Bukit Baru, Malacca.

Built at a cost of about RM50 million, the MMMC is owned and managed by JVMC Sdn Bhd, a joint venture between Yayasan Melaka Education, MEMG International and the late Datuk K. Pathmanaban.

As of yesterday, the New Straits Times-initiated fund stood at RM1,072,590.31.
