ADDITIONAL KTM COMMUTER SERVICE ON JUNE 13

KUALA LUMPUR, June 1 (Bernama) -- KTM Berhad will mount additional services in conjunction with the official opening of the KL Central Station by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad on June 13.

The KTM Commuter service would be extended until 1am when the normal service ended around 11pm, KTM said in a statement.

A total of 14 additional services would be provided after the normal service had ended, at 30-minute intervals on the Rawang, Seremban and Port Klang sectors.

The additional service was to promote the use of the KL Central Station by KTM commuter patrons, the statement said.

The extension was also for the convenience of the people who would be attending the opening celebrations which were expected to end around 11.30pm.

KTM Komuter which began serving the KL Central Station on April 16 handles some 3,000 passengers daily at the station.
