Avenues to voice grouses

THE Government has provided adequate avenues for university students to voice their grievances and they should make full use of this and not resort to unlawful methods.

Education Ministry Parliamentary Secretary Datuk Mahadzir Mohd Khir said even Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad had frequent meetings and dialogue sessions with students.

"The Government has never restricted or cut off the opportunity for students to speak their minds and there is no reason why they should resort to unlawful methods," he said when winding up on points raised by Shaziman Abu Mansor (BN-Tampin).
