BAKTI TO BUILD COMMUNITY CENTRE IN BUKIT KIARA

PUTRAJAYA, July 18 (Bernama) -- The Charitable Organisation of Wives of Ministers and Deputy Ministers (Bakti) plans to build a community centre in Bukit Kiara, its President Datin Seri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohamed Ali said today.

Bakti would organise a charity dinner on July 27 to raise funds for the project, she said when speaking at Bakti's 24th annual general meeting here.

The meeting was opened by Attorney-General Tan Sri Ainum Mohd Saaid.

Bakti recently handed over the keys to the Welfare Services Department for the newly-completed Kompleks Penyayang Bakti in Sri Damansara which will house senior citizens, children and single mothers.
