BRUNEI SULTAN CALLS ON AGONG

SINGAPORE, Oct 3 (Bernama) -- The Yang di-Pertuan Agong Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah, who is here for a medical check-up at Mount Elizabeth Hospital, today received a visit by Sultan Hassanal Bolkiah of Brunei.

Sultan Hassanal made a stopover here on his way home after a three-day official visit to Kuala Lumpur.

An aide to Sultan Salahuddin said Sultan Hassanal spent an hour with the King who was also visited today by the Tunku Mahkota of Johor Tunku Ibrahim Ismail.

The Regent of Selangor Tengku Idris Shah and Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad had called on the King last week.

The King's private secretary Datuk Raja Hydar Raja Iskandar told Bernama in Kuala Lumpur last night Sultan Salahuddin was in stable condition after a second examination prior to a minor surgery.

"Tuanku is good health and there is nothing to worry about," he said.
