IF you have been waiting to own a Kijang Emas gold coin, now is the chance to get it for less than market price at Mid Valley Megamall in Kuala Lumpur.

Twenty-five ounce pure gold coins at a reserve price of RM200 each will be auctioned at the Kijang Emas roadshow from Friday till Sunday.

A host of other fun activities have been lined up, providing great opportunities to take home a Kijang Emas coin.

These include matching your weight in gold, fishing for the Kijang Emas with a pair of chopsticks, and guessing the number of coins.

The Kijang Emas, minted in 999.9 pure gold, was launched by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad in July this year, joining the ranks of gold bullion coins from the United States, Canada, Australia and South Africa.

Issued and guaranteed by Bank Negara Malaysia, the Kijang Emas coins - available in denominations of quarter-ounce, half-ounce and one ounce - are legal tender.

The coins can be bought at Maybank and Bank Bumiputra-Commerce branches nationwide.
