Chronology of events

JUNE 27, 1994 - The Government awarded the concession to design and construct the new KL railway station to a consortium led by MRCB, on the 28.8ha Brickfields railway marshalling yard.

April 1996 - Launch of Plaza Sentral featuring four blocks of office suites offering corporate and penthouse suites with modern architectural designs.

Sept 3, 1996 - Signing of joint-venture agreement between MRCB and Pidemco Land Ltd to develop condominiums within KL Sentral phase one development area; collaboration to construct two blocks of 400-unit condominiums.

April 2, 1997 - Signing of tri-partite joint-venture agreement to develop KL Sentral's integrated retail precinct by MRCB, Fraser & Neave Holdings Bhd and Centrepont Properties Ltd.

April 15, 1997 - Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad officiates at ground-breaking ceremony of Stesen Sentral Kuala Lumpur.

March 6, 2000 - Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi officiates at topping-up ceremony of Stesen Sentral Kuala Lumpur building structure.

May 2000 - Kuala Lumpur Datuk Bandar Tan Sri Kamaruzzaman Shariff opens Info Sentral.

August 2000 - Incorporation of Semasa Sentral Sdn Bhd as the management of Stesen Sentral.

Oct 12, 2000 - Transport Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ling Liong Sik witnesses handing-over of works at Stesen Sentral to Express Rail Link Sdn Bhd and Project Usahasama Transit Ringan Automatik Sdn Bhd (PUTRA), giving access to both companies and their contractors to proceed with completion of their respective areas at the station.

Nov 2000 - Stesen Sentral KL building construction completed.

Feb 15, 2001 - Temporary Certificate of Fitness issued to Stesen Sentral KL.

April 2001 - Station begins operations.
