CONDOLENCE BOOK AT THE US EMBASSY STILL AVAILABLE NEXT WEEK

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 14 (Bernama) -- The condolence book for those who wish to express their sympathy for the many victims of Tuesday's terrorist attacks in the United States will continue to be available off the lobby of the US embassy from Monday until Wednesday next week.

It is open from 9.30am to 3.30pm daily, said the US embassy's press office in a statement issued here today.

Among the Malaysian leaders who signed the condolence book today were Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, Foreign Minister Datuk Seri Syed Hamid Albar and Works Minister Datuk Seri S Samy Vellu.

Thousands are feared to have perished in the attacks when two hijacked commercial airplanes rammmed into the World Trade Centre twin towers in New York while another slammed into the Pentagon complex which houses the Defence Department in Washington.
