Conference to highlight changes in transport

WELL-KNOWN industry figures - Datuk Elias Kadir, managing director of Kontena Nasional Bhd, Datuk Dr Jason Goh, president of Association of Forwarding Agents Port Klang and Mirzan Mahathir, president of CHAM - are among those who will be convening on June 21-22 at the first "Malaysia Transport Chain" Conference in Kuala Lumpur.
