Council to get proposals report

BARISAN Nasional secretary-general Tan Sri Mohamed Rahmat said he would submit a report to the BN supreme council on suggestions raised by component party leaders during the coalition's national convention yesterday and methods to implement them.

Mohamed said among them was a proposal that the BN supreme council meet more regularly instead of twice a year, as is the current practice.

He said BN leaders had many other forums to discuss important matters such as the weekly Cabinet and the State executive council meetings.

The convention, he said, was intended to strengthen coalition and fulfil BN's responsibility to the country and the people.

Mohamed said BN headquarters produced the Balancing Communal Rights book and video compact disc launched by BN chairman Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad during the convention. The book, a limited edition, is launched in "coffee-table" and paperback editions.

"Our intention in producing these materials is to benefit the BN coalition members."
