CUEPACS SUBMITS MEMORANDUM ON NATIONAL SOLIDARITY

KANGAR, March 17 (Bernama) -- Cuepacs will submit a memorandum on national solidarity to the government in the near future, said its president N. Siva Subramaniam.

Without stating who or which ministry the memorandum would be addressed to, he said that among other things, the memorandum would outline three aspects that would again enhance racial unity which had already been forged.

The three aspects are the inculcation of the spirit of brotherhood, understanding the importance of the various cultures of the multi-racial Malaysians and mutual respect among the races.

Speaking to reporters after officiating the seminar on women's education organised by the Perlis branch of the National Union of Teaching Profession (NUTP) here, he said Cuepacs had also held a meeting with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad on national solidarity a few days back.

Siva, who is also NUTP secretary-general, said besides Cuepacs, the NUTP would also give its views on the restructuring of the national education system as it was found to have several weaknesses.

Fifty women teachers attended the one-day seminar which, among other things, aimed to improve the performance of the teaching service in the state.
