CUEPACS' MAY DAY CELEBRATIONS TO FOCUS ON I.T. AND K-ECONOMY

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 26 (Bernama) -- This year's Workers Day celebration organised by Cuepacs will focus on the role and development of information technology and knowledge-based economy.

Cuepacs president N.Siva Subramaniam said this was in line with the stress given to IT and k-economy by the Government to ensure Malaysia remained competitive in the globalisation era.

"The people expect excellent service and public servants must be ready to face the challenges of the new millennium," he told reporters.
