`Umno committed to victory'

KOTA KINABALU, Tues. - Umno supreme council member Datuk Seri Salleh Said Keruak has advised the people of Sarawak not to be deceived by certain quarters who claimed to have the support of Umno.

He hoped the statement by Prime Minister and Umno president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad on the matter yesterday would put an end to any talk or rumour of Umno supporting certain groups in the forthcoming Sarawak State election.

"Those who still make use of Umno's name are desperate people who do not deserve to be supported," Salleh told reporters on his arrival here, today, after attending yesterday's Umno supreme council meeting.

Salleh, who is also Sabah Umno deputy liaison chief, said Umno was committed towards ensuring a resounding victory for the Barisan Nasional in the Sarawak election.

"There are no two ways about it ... Umno is all for a landslide BN victory in the Sarawak election," said Salleh, who is also the State Local Government and Housing Minister.

Sabah Umno would send a strong delegation to campaign for the BN in the election.
