Don't use party for self gain, says Najib

SEREMBAN, Sun. - Umno members must not regard the party as a vehicle to achieve self gain or the party will be destroyed, Umno vice-president Datuk Seri Najib Razak said today.

He said members must not issue threats when they were no longer accepted by the grassroots or when they were found to be guilty of breach of discipline.

Najib was speaking after briefing Rasah Umno members at Wisma Negri today.

Leaders and members who failed to show a high level of discipline would impede Umno's efforts to unite the Malays.

He was asked to comment on a statement by Muar Umno division chief Datuk Abdullah Omar who said he may quit the party if his appeal to the supreme council who found him guilty of "money politics" was turned down.

Umno president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad had said the party would not bow to threats by those found to be guilty of being involved in money politics.
