Dr M brought benefits to people, says Abdul Hadi

TASIK KENYIR, Tues. - Pas today acknowledged it had benefited from the changes brought about by Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad during his 20 years as Prime Minister. Pas deputy president Abdul Hadi Awang said the party had the opportunity to take part in the democratic process as well as the Government's focus on information technology.
