Dr M to meet 400 students at UUM

SINTOK, Sat. - Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad will hold a dialogue on current issues with 400 students representing the National Students Consultative Council on Monday.

The dialogue will be held at Universiti Utara Malaysia after Dr Mahathir attends the Raja of Perlis' installation ceremony.

The Prime Minister is expected to field questions on a wide range of issues, including the University and University Colleges Act.

"It will be a very open session where students will have an opportunity to ask whatever they want.

"The students will be able to get answers from the Prime Minister on current social and political issues," UUM deputy vice-chancellor (students affairs) Datuk Dr Ahmad Fawzi Mohd Basri said.

Ahmad Fawzi said the students will also get an opportunity to talk to lecturers from various institutions of higher learning at a convention which starts today at UUM.1

The three-day convention is organised by deputy vice-chancellors and deputy rectors with the co-operation of Biro Tatanegara.
