DR MAHATHIR WOULD BE INFORMED OF KHOR'S MEDICAL CONDITION

KANGAR, Nov 18 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad would be informed of the medical condition of the State Assemblyman for Indera Kayangan, Datuk Khor Liang Tee who is being treated at a private hospital in Kuala Lumpur.

Perlis Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Shahidan Kassim said he would submit a formal letter to Dr Mahathir tomorrow on the latest development concerning Khor who is also the Perlis Exco for Housing and Local Government.

Khor, 59, is being warded at the Intensive Care Unit of the Gleneagles Medical Centre, Jalan Ampang and is on a life support machine, he told reporters after a meeting with leaders of the Barisan Nasional (BN) component parties in the Indera Kayangan constituency, here today.

He has been receiving treatment at the hospital for the past two months.

Shahidan said he had visited Khor at the private hospital yesterday and found that his condition was rather serious.

Khor, was diagnosed as suffering from cancer of the colon two years ago and had been receiving frequent treatment in Kuala Lumpur.

He has been Perlis MCA chairman since 1990 and had been the Assemblyman for Indera Kayangan for the past three terms.

Asked on his meeting with the BN party leaders in Indera Kayangan today, Shahidan said it was a normal meeting.
