Dr M to attend celebrations by Cuepacs today

KUALA LUMPUR, Mon. - Workers Day tomorrow will see Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad attending a celebration organised by the Congress of Unions of Employees in the Public and Civil Services (Cuepacs).

The celebration will be held at the National Institute of Public Administration (Intan) in Bukit Kiara, where Dr Mahathir will hear a pledge by workers' representatives and later deliver a speech.

The Malaysian Trades Union Congress will celebrate with a symbolic march to its headquarters in Subang Jaya and the handing over of a women workers' memorandum to its president Senator Zainal Rampak.

In SEREMBAN, Menteri Besar Tan Sri Mohamad Isa Abdul Samad called on workers to remember their responsibility towards the country.

In PENANG, the 16th Workers Day Joy Run, held in conjunction with the Workers Day celebration, will be held in Teluk Bahang at 8am tomorrow. Some 700 runners will compete in the 10km run.

Chief Minister Tan Sri Dr Koh Tsu Koon will attend a dinner in conjunction with the Workers Day celebration at Taman Chai Ling multi-purpose hall, in Prai at 7.45pm.

In JOHOR, the South East Johor Development Authority will organise the Tanjung Balau Festival 2001 in conjunction with Workers Day at the Tanjung Balau Tourism Complex in Kota Tinggi.
