DR MAHATHIR HOSTS DINNER FOR BOSNIAN PRESIDENT

PUTRAJAYA, March 20 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad tonight hosted a dinner for visiting Bosnia and Herzegovina President Dr Halid Genjac at Seri Perdana here.

Also present at the dinner were Deputy Foreign Minister Datuk Leo Michael Toyad and Deputy Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Senator Datuk Tengku Adnan Tengku Mansor.

The Bosnian leader, on a four-day private visit to Malaysia, arrived yesterday.

Earlier today, Dr Genjac called on Dr Mahathir during which they discussed ways to enhance ties between Kuala Lumpur and Sarajevo.

Dr Genjac is scheduled to visit the Multimedia Development Corporation (MDC) in Cyberjaya, the National Institute of Public Administration (Intan) in Bukit Kiara and the world's tallest buildings, the Petronas Twin Towers, in Kuala Lumpur.

He will visit the historical city of Melaka tomorrow.
