EQUATORIAL GUINEAN PRESIDENT TO VISIT MALAYSIA

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 12 (Bernama) -- President Obiang Nguema Mbasogo of Equatorial Guinea will make a two-day state visit to Malaysia beginning Thursday, according to Wisma Putra.

The president will be accompanied by his wife and a 30-member delegation comprising four ministers, senior officials and members of the Press.

The visit, the first by a president of the republic, is aimed at enhancing ties between the two countries, Wisma Putra said in a statement.

Mbasogo is scheduled to have an audience with the Deputy Yang di-Pertuan Agong Sultan Mizan Zainal Abidin and lead a delegation meeting with Malaysia.

Discussions between him and the Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad would focus on bilateral cooperation as well as regional and international issues of common interest, the statement added.
