Exhibition on research findings

KUALA LUMPUR, Sun. - The Education Ministry and Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia are organising an exhibition on the research findings of public institutions of higher learning.

The four-day exhibition will be held at Dewan Tun Razak 3, Putra World Trade Centre, from Oct 25.

The exhibition was mooted by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad when he opened the UKM-MTDC Smart Technology Centre on Sept 9, 1999.

Dr Mahathir had said that such an exhibition would give an opportunity to the institutions to publicise their research findings and programmes.

The exhibition will highlight research in science and technology, social science with an emphasis on the agro-industry, information technology, health, environment, engineering science and economic social science.

UKM vice-chancellor professor Datuk Dr Anuwar Ali, who is also the organising chairman, said 14 institutions are planning to show off a total of 400 research and development projects.

The institutions are UKM, Universiti Malaya, Universiti Putra Malaysia, Universiti Sains Malaysia, Universiti Teknologi Malaysia, Universiti Malaysia Sabah, Universiti Malaysia Sarawak, Universiti Teknologi Mara, Universiti Utara Malaysia, Universiti Islam Antarabangsa, Universiti Pengurusan Sultan Idris, Kolej Universiti Teknologi Maklumat dan Komunikasi, Kolej Universiti Sains dan Teknologi Malaysia and Kolej Universiti Teknologi Tun Hussein Onn.
