Five MoUs worth RM30 million sealed

FIVE Memorandum of Understandings (MoUs) worth more than RM30 million were signed at the Maritime division of the Langkawi International Maritime and Aerospace 2001 exhibition, yesterday.

The MoUs were signed by Business Focus Intra Sdn Bhd (a company under Business Focus group), Comintel Bhd, Dawn Enterprise Sdn Bhd, Langkawi Sea farms Sdn Bhd and Comlenia Sdn Bhd.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad witnessed the signing ceremony at the Awana Porto Malai Hotel yesterday.

Also present at the ceremony were Defence Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak and HW Lima Sdn Bhd executive chairman Tan Sri Abdul Wahab Nawi.

Business Focus Intra Sdn Bhd (BFI) signed an MoU with the National Philippines Police to supply the force with 10 units of urgently needed high speed patrols boats.

The agreement was signed by BFI director Abdul Basit Asi Nizami and Philippines police director, General Reynaldo Velasco.

Abdul Basit said the project was valued at RM18 million.

He said construction of these boats would start at BFI's dockyard in Lumut soon.

Comintel signed the agreement with GEM Elettronica S.R.L of Italy to establish a joint operation for complete operational support for the Italian company's Far East customer.

Comintel was represented by its chairman Tan Sri Shamsuri Arshad and GEM by its business director Derenzis Glovanni.
