I will wait and see, says Abdul Hadi

KUALA TERENGGANU, Tues. - Pas deputy president Abdul Hadi Awang said he "will wait and see" regarding the action that will be taken against him for not retracting the Amanat Haji Hadi (Haji Hadi Decree).

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad said yesterday that a study would be made on the action to be taken (against Abdul Hadi) to ensure that the National Fatwa Council's decision is accepted by all.

Dr Mahathir had expressed regret over Abdul Hadi's decision not to retract the decree.

"It shows he does not respect the decision made by the National Fatwa Council which is of the opinion that the decree is contrary to Islamic teachings."

Meanwhile, Pas vice-president Mustafa Ali said he was not aware of any decision by the National Fatwa Council that what Abdul Hadi had said in 1986 during a ceramah in Banggol Peradong was a decree.

"We have to check what was the decision made by the National Fatwa Council. Dr Mahathir could have mistaken the decision for the latest one made by the council and not the one made 15 years ago."
